### PROGRAM DATES:

September 7, 2010 until the last day of school. Programs are provided on most school holidays, winter and spring break and inclement weather days (check your school calendar for school closings). Additional fees apply.

### HOURS OF OPERATION:

6:00 a.m. to School opening - children are transported from the YMCA to school.  
School dismissal to 6:00 p.m. - children are transported from school to the YMCA.

### TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation is provided for most traditional Hampton City Schools. For details, contact your YMCA Representative at 722-9044.

### REGISTRATION:

Monday - Friday only, 12:30 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. or by appointment.

- Current School Age Participants begin registering April 12, 2010 at the YMCA.
- YMCA Members begin registering April 19, 2010 at the YMCA.
- Open Registration begins April 26, 2010 at the YMCA.

After September 1st registration is taken year-round, first come first served. You must bring payment for the first week and \$40 registration fee (per child) to registration as well as a copy of your child's school physical, shot record and original birth certificate. Due to licensing requirements, incomplete registrations cannot be processed.

### PAYMENT:

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) is the Peninsula Metropolitan YMCA's preferred method of payment for your School Age tuition. Fees are automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account either weekly or monthly, per your request. Financial Assistance is available. If you are financially not able to pay the full amount, please ask about the Guardian Program.
