REGISTRATION

PROGRAM DATES

The School-Age program is available from the first day of school until the last day of school. Programs are provided on most school holidays, winter and spring break, and inclement weather days (check your school calendar for school closings). Additional fees apply.

HOURS OF OPERATION

6:00 a.m. to school opening - children are transported from the YMCA School-Age site to school.

School dismissal to 6:00 p.m. - children are transported from school to the YMCA School-Age site.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation is provided for most traditional Hampton City Schools. For details, contact your Y.

After school starts registration is taken year-round on a first-come first-served basis. You must bring payment for the first week and \$40 registration fee (per child) to registration as well as a copy of your child's school physical, shot record, and original birth certificate. Due to licensing requirements, incomplete registrations cannot be processed.

PAYMENT

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) is the Peninsula Metropolitan YMCA's preferred method of payment for your School-Age tuition. Fees are automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account either weekly or monthly, per your request. Financial Assistance is available for those not able to pay the full amount, please ask about the Guardian program.
