PROGRAM DATES:

September 7, 2010 until the last day of school. Programs are provided on most school holidays, winter and spring break and inclement weather days (check your school calendar for school closings). Additional fee applies.

HOURS OF OPERATION:

6:30 a.m. to School opening and School dismissal to 6:00 p.m.
Limited part-time care available at each school site. Call 365-4060 for information.

REGISTRATION:

Registration begins NOW at each school site and at the Luter Family YMCA. Beginning September 7, 2010 registrations will be taken at each school site.

You must bring payment for the first week and \$40 registration fee (per child) to registration as well as a copy of your child's school physical, shot record and original birth certificate. Due to licensing requirements, incomplete registrations cannot be processed.

- WEEKLY FEES:** Before School\$42
- After School\$53
- Before and After School\$70

Additional children in the same program receive \$5.00 off weekly fee. Discount does not apply to the Before School program.

PAYMENT: Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) is the Peninsula Metropolitan YMCA's preferred method of payment for your School Age tuition. Fees are automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account either weekly or monthly, per your request. Financial Assistance is available. If you are financially not able to pay the full amount, please ask about the Guardian Program.
