PROGRAM DATES

Poquoson - Beginning May 23 by appointment Monday - Friday only at the Victory Family YMCA, 101 Long Green Boulevard, Yorktown, VA 23693 or during program hours at Poquoson Primary School.

Victory and Poquoson - After school starts registration is taken year-round as space allows. You must bring payment for the first week and \$40 registration fee (per child to registration as well as a copy of your child's school physical, shot record, and original birth certificate. Due to licensing requirements, incomplete registrations cannot be processed.

PAYMENT

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) is the Peninsula Metropolitan YMCA's preferred method of payment for your School-Age tuition. Fees are automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account either weekly or monthly, per your request. Financial Assistance is available for those not able to pay the full amount, please ask about the Guardian program.
